Please see information below re St Johns Choir

I am writing to let you know about opportunities for children to sing at St John's Ranmoor.

The choir at St John's is one of the best Parish Church choirs in the country. There are two or three choral services each week led by various combinations of our Adult Choir, Choristers



and Junior Choir. We offer our Choristers and Juniors tuition from professional music tutors, individual singing lessons, training in reading music and music theory and an introduction to exploring the Christian faith. There are opportunities for concerts and tours and they receive regular pay.

The Junior choir, whose members rehearse every Monday evening and sing two Sunday services per month, is for children aged between 5 and 9. We find that Year 1 or Year 2 is usually the best time to start.

The Choristers, who rehearse every Monday and Wednesday and sing one Sunday service per week, is for ages 8 to 16. We would welcome any children within that age range but find that Years 4 and 5 are often the ideal starting point. We currently have 16 Choristers, ranging from Year 4 to Year 8. They are a very dedicated and talented group who pride themselves on being welcoming to new members and for supporting younger, less experienced choristers.

On the first Sunday of each month, we have a “Pop-up Choir” where any children can turn up and be a chorister for the morning and get a sense of what it’s like without having to commit. **Our first Pop-up Choir this year will be this Sunday 6th October** – no experience necessary, they would just need to come along at 9.15 and they would be taught everything they need to be able to take part in the service at 10.30am. It is our “animal service” on 6th October where people can bring their pets to the service – any children coming to sing would be welcome to bring their pets (within reason) and/or dress in an animal onesie if they wanted.
